SUMMARY

Install, repair and maintain propane tanks and provide service to our residential and industrial customers by performing the following duties.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Pressure test gas service lines to make sure system passes all state & local installation/permit requirements.

Examine pipelines and equipment to locate leaks and faulty pipe connections and determine pressure and flow of gas.

Daily completion of any and all paper work required, proper documentation of tests conducted (pressure / leak tests).

Daily completion and proper documentation of DOT pre-trip vehicle inspections.

Operate company vehicle in a safe manner and be insurable.

Fill customers' tanks and bobtail trucks.

Train customers on the safe transfer of propane.

REQUIREMENTS

Class A or B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) containing a Hazmat, Tank and Air Brake Endorsements and DOT Medical Card.

- Ability to pass pre-employment DOT physical, Drug Test and Homeland Security Background Check.

High school diploma or general education degree (GED).

Must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to propane fumes and outside weather conditions. The employee is occasionally exposed to moving mechanical parts and vibration. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate and occasionally loud.
